Representatives from Canvas will be leading various workshops **May 8-9, 2024**. Participants can attend remotely or onsite at the Athens campus in Walter Hall 253, and sessions will be recorded for later access.

Workshops will be available for both faculty and sub-account administrators covering a variety of topics, including creating content, course communication, course data & analytics, outcomes & competencies for admins, and more. Topics were selected based on user feedback and educational interests.

Dr. Micah McCarey, director of OHIO's Pride Center, will be the primary presenter at an [Inclusive Excellence Learning Session](#) on **Wednesday, May 1, at 1 p.m.** to explore strategies for effective dialogue from the book *Conversations Worth Having: Using Appreciative Inquiry to Fuel Productive and Meaningful Engagement*.

The session will build on last month's discussion with Mac Stricklen about the book *Difficult Conversations: How to Discuss What Matters Most*. Mac will also join the session on May 1 to help draw connections among the various communication strategies being explored.
