Slate CRM Reimplementation to Transform Undergraduate Admissions at OHIO

The **Slate Reimplementation Team** launched a new Undergraduate Slate instance this month that will make the process of applying to Ohio University easier, faster and more intuitive.

The new instance allows students to edit their existing application, request recommendations directly from their application, and track their application status in a new online portal. The portal also includes a new digital reveal to help students celebrate their admission to OHIO.



Phase 1 Underway: Streamlining Access for OHIO IT

Recently, many of our campus partners have requested access to the [OHIO IT Microsoft Team](#) and [intranet](#). Up until now, we've been provisioning access to these services on an ad-hoc basis, which results in confusion around who has access to what and is difficult to manage.

To streamline access and to provide clarity around access levels, we're going to start using identity management (IDM) roles to populate the OIT and OHIO IT Microsoft Teams starting **Friday, September 5 at noon**. (You can learn more on our [SharePoint page](#)).



Outcome

OHIO IT and Tech Partners will consistently have access to our OHIO IT Team and our OHIO IT intranet.

Impact

We do not anticipate a disruption of service. We do expect a flurry of notifications, so we recommend turning on *do not disturb* in Microsoft Teams or turning off your [channel notifications](#) for the OHIO IT general channel from 12 to 1 p.m.

Change in Process

- Moving forward, if someone would like access to the OHIO IT Team/intranet but they do not have a technology-related job, a sponsor (typically a people or product manager in OHIO IT) will submit a *Technology Partner form through TeamDynamix* to grant them access.
- Since the process will now be automated, it will no longer be possible to manually add members to the OIT or OHIO IT team.
